Tell us a little about yourself and your family, how long you have lived in the area and your occupation.: We have lived in Coeur d'Alene since October of 1999. We moved here from the SF Bay area with our then 2 year old daughter. I have worked in the technology software and computing industry for 30 years and am currently employed full time as a consultant in that area.

1. Do you have experience as an elected official and if so, what was your position, and how would you describe your voting record?: I do not have experience as an elected official, but I have voted in nearly every election for the past 30 years and have always voted for the Republican Candidates.

2. Please tell us about your activity as a Republican. Have you previously voted for candidates of other parties? If yes, explain.: I have always voted for the Republican candidate in every race and have donated to many local and national campaigns.

3. What is the purpose of government?: To serve the people by protecting their God given rights as written in the US and State constitutions.

4. Describe why you are running for this particular office. What are your qualifications? What are your goals?: I am running for city council to help bring a local voice to the future plans and evolution of our city that seems to have been hijacked by global central planners with unclear objects. I have a bachelor of science in business administration and have negotiated contracts with many large corporations.

They visited the following week and based on their interview decided to make an arrest.

17 years ago in 2006 I was pulled over as I was leaving a bar for not using my turn signal. I failed the field sobriety test. In retrospect I am grateful I was stopped before something tragic happened. It was a failure in judgement that I will NEVER repeat.

Describe how you will make yourself available to your constituents and vote as their representative with FORTITUDE, adhering to the values and answers you have stated above.: I will be publicly available at forums and townhalls as well as by phone and social media and will be responsive to my local constituents.
